Two young men died early on Saturday morning after they crashed their motorbike into iron barricades that were put up for road diversions on the Eastern Express Highway (EEH) at Chunabhatti. The victims have been identified as Chetan Shelar, 26, and Rahul Kadam, 27. This is the fourth accident that has claimed lives on the EEH, the highway that connects the island city and Thane, in the last two

BKC-Chunabhatti fly-over which is underway at that stretch on the EEH. The Chunabhatti police have registered a case against Shelar in this regard alleging that he was speeding. He has been booked under Indian Penal Code (IPC) section 279 (rash driving or riding on a public way) and 304 A (causing death by negligence). Police attribute a number of reasons

Should we insult them, call them thieves and robbers? Is this the way? "But whoever (among corporates) does the wrong, he should either have to leave the country or live in jail. It would not happen earlier because a lot happened behind the curtains then." Pointing at former BJP leader Amar Singh, who was in the news, Modi said that Singh can give details of such deals of "those people". "Do people not know who is flying in whose plane?" Modi said with a sarcastic smile.

Iran Khan to take oath

The Dawn reported that Former secretary general of the PTI Jahangir Tareen had established contacts with independents and the Muttahida Qaumi Movement-Pakistan (MQM-P) which has won six seats. There are 13 independents who have won the seats. If the PTI obtains support of the GDA, MQM-P, PML-Q and the Awami Muslim League, the number of its seats will become 122 — still 15 short of the required numbers, which is more than 100 independents who have won the elections. Other parties which will have representation in the NA are Balochistan National Party-Mengal (BNP-M) with three members, and Jamhoori Watan Party, Awami National Party and Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf with one seat each. Though the PPP and PML-N have also rejected the elections results, representatives in the two parties told Dawn that they would support the Muttahida Majlis-i-Amal (MMA)'s bid for boycotting the oath-taking session of the National Assembly.
